We imagine... 1000 Youth Giving Circles, by 2013, each having raise \$10,000 (3,000-\$10,000 each x 1-2 circles in each location during this time period) will mean \$1 million more for social justice organizations.

Phase One: August 2007-July 22, 2009

- Needs Assessment
- Trial program for 7 youth in Houston
- Drafting concept
- Obtain seed funding (10k from Welk Foundation and 3 others)
- Field research and draft of tools/curriculum
- Obtain more funding for writing of curriculum/tools and worksheets
- Establish committee and two prime consultants on project:
 - Sondra Shaw-Hardy and Karen Payne as writers
 - PassageWorks (Soul of Education authors and advisors) as editors and reviewers
- Rewrites and more planning for outreach
- Final documents, proofed, designed and made available to those registering for pilot phase.
- Haley Jenkins named as spokesperson

LAUNCH Pilot Phase Launch:

- Make final pilot materials available for registered users
- PR and outreach (press release, July 22, 2009 to 1800 providers of Donor Education and 500 after school programs/teachers and kids)

Phase Two: July 23, 2009-end of pilot (PLANS IN PROGRESS)

- Goals:
 - have at least a variety of 5 programs supported to completion
 - have help evaluating carefully what works and what does not
 - have youth and adults who have put together youth giving circle's based on our model or others.
- Marketing and Business Plan developed
- Budget finalized for Phase Two
- Funding for next phase sought ([let us know if you want to be a sponsor or see a proposal](#))
- Coaching on Youth Giving Circles offered to the best of our abilities
- Youth Giving Circle Coordinator job description refined and funding sought for at least 10 hours per week. (Once funded, additional outreach and support will be offered.)
- Various new tools developed for supporting and growing Youth Giving Circle community at Inspired Legacies and our Inspired Leader Tools
- Through a subscription based site: coaching, trainings, sponsorships and eventually a speakers bureau

Feb. 14, 2013: we want to have leveraged: 1000 new youth giving circles world wide, raising in the three years on average at least \$10,000 while transforming themselves, their families, and their communities.
